We have an exciting semester of Spanish 2 ahead! During the upcoming semester, students will be expected to be able to perform various tasks pertaining to the Spanish language. Our curriculum will follow the "Descubre" textbook series as well as the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Language (ACTFL) Proficiency Guidelines. These guidelines are an instrument for the evaluation of functional language ability. Students will gradually progress from a Novice High level to an eventual Intermediate Mid level by reading, writing, listening, and speaking Spanish throughout the year. As we advance through the book students will be assessed multiple times per unit in order to track their progress. And don't worry, culture is always part of learning a foreign language!

All homework and class work must be completed and students must make good effort in class in order to receive extra credit assignments.

Quizzes can be retaken once for a better grade and you will earn the highest grade. Retaking quizzes is a which can be revoked if abused. Tests are not eligible for retakes.
